

Procurement Policy
Singha Estate Public Company Limited
(Extract)

- Having a transparent, systematic, and efficient vendor selection and procurement process, including complying with anti-corruption practices of Singha Estate Public Company Limited (the “Company”);
- Treating vendors in accordance with the Company's Business Code of Conduct, including actively seeking their feedback and suggestions, to build and maintain strong relationships that foster efficiency in business collaboration;
- Promoting vendors to comply with the Company's Business Partner Code of Conduct which is a part of sustainable supply chain management;
- Refraining from transacting with individuals or juristic persons that engage in illegal activities, violate intellectual property rights, or infringe on human rights, including vendors with a history of corruption and bribery, or behavior that leads to such practices;
- Encouraging, supporting and conducting procurement process with vendors whose businesses produce goods or services on the energy conservation and eco-friendly (Green Procurement) basis, in which the key considerations are as follows:
 - Criteria in relation to environment for vendors assessment and selection processes;
 - Procurement on goods on an efficiency basis, e.g. products that are durable, do not need to be replaced frequently, and do not cause pollution throughout their lifespan;
 - Procuring only goods certified with production standards, environmental management standards or occupational health and safety management standards or ECO Label certification;
 - Procuring only goods on efficient transportation and distribution systems, e.g. minimizing excessive packaging or utilizing transportation methods with a low environmental impact;
 - Procuring only goods with effective end-of-life management systems and responsible for manufacturing waste management in appropriate manner;

- Supporting vendors in upholding occupational health and safety standards across their operations, including the work processes of the employees, vendors and contractors, as well as promoting understanding within relevant communities to ensure a secure work environment with minimal social and environmental impacts;
- Assisting and encouraging vendors who have not yet fully embrace green procurement practices by offering recommendations for improvement, correction, and development towards a sustainable supply chain network.
